



3 BOHEMIA SUITES & SPA. GRAN CANARIA

THE PAD Towering over the 3km of Playa del Inglés beach, Bohemia is all jewel tones and polished wood, with free-flowing cava at breakfast, two heated pools (one to catch the morning sun, one for the afternoon) and a rooftop bar with panoramic views over the Atlantic. We felt totally refreshed after a 60-minute Bali massage with foot scrub, £85, at the gorgeous spa, plus



all guests get given free use of a 4G Galaxy S3 tablet, so you can order room service or scroll Insta on the go!

OUT & ABOUT Visit the Island's capital Las Palmas, a 40-minute drive away, and start your day in the old town, with its cobbled streets and coloured stone buildings.
